A274 NORTH STREET, BIDDENDEN

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A274 North Street, Biddenden, near Tenterden.

Overnight works are planned from Thursday 13 September 2018 for up to 3 weekday nights, between 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

Works will be done in 2 main phases, as indicated on site

Main Phase – A274 North Street will be closed between the junctions with A262 High Street / Tenterden Road and Mansion House Close
The alternative route for all through traffic is via A262 High Street, Sissinghurst Road, Hareplain Road, Frittenden Road, A274 Headcorn Road and North Street

Personnel will be on site to allow managed entry for any residents affected, including access to Cloth Hall Gardens, Townland Close and The Weavers, but there are likely to be delays during active works.

Subsidiary phase – works at the junction with A274 North Street and A262 High Street, with traffic controlled by three-way temporary traffic lights.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of the short section of A262 High Street north of Biddenden Village Green will be suspended so it becomes two-way.
